Questions in Latin

Adding **ne** to the first word in the sentence makes it a question.

So **cantasne?** Are you singing? Do you sing?

Questions in Latin

We can also make questions in Latin by using question words:

ubi	where?
cur	why?
quis	who?
quid	what?

Questions in Latin

ubi	where?
cur	why?
quis	who?
quid	what?

cur cantatis? Why are you (*pl.*) singing?

Why do you sing?

ubi cantat? Where is she singing?

Where does she sing?

Note the *is, are, does, do* are 'contained' in the verb.
